Matt wants to make sure fees are reasonable/simple. *See print out of each grade school fees and field trips actual cost. Discussion about breakdown of fees, making up difference, what happens when some don't pay their fees. Example of fees for 2020-2021: Mandatory fees relate to curriculum approx \$45 for 2-3 field trips. Optional fees such as swimming and skiing. Parent discussion about possibly having each grade do 1 bigger trip ie: skiing only for Grade 4s.

7. **Trustee Report** – 2020-2021 Calendar on the EIPS website. April 24-26 ASCA conference and annual general meeting in Edmonton. EIPS sponsoring 12 people to go if anyone is interested. School status report: breakdown of each student to attend each school average \$7295. At ALH is \$8,067. Transportation fees: 5000 students who don't pay for bussing. Proposal to charge all students a fee, so if they are outside the 2.39KM it could be ¼ of the \$414.50 bus fee. There are 15,000 new students expected in AB next year, with no additional funding. Currently working with 8 millions less than last year.
